## Call for Clinical Poster Abstracts

Abstracts for poster presentations are now being accepted for the 39th Snowbird CME Conference to be held at the Snowbird Center on August 5-7, 2015. Clinicians, students and faculty at all levels of clinical practice and academia are encouraged to submit abstracts describing creative, practice-based projects related to either acute or primary patient-care.

Abstracts will be selected by a competitive, peer-reviewed process according to the following criteria: (a) uniqueness, (b) organization, (c) significance to quality patient care, and (d) implications for primary care practice. Topics for submission will be considered in the areas specific to research, evidence based practice, health care policy as well as theoretical and concept analysis.

Those participants presenting posters are eligible to win free registration for next years conference. Scores from the peer-review process will be combined with votes of conference participants for best poster; the presenter with the highest score will receive free registration for the 39th Annual Snowbird Conference.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### Submission Deadline

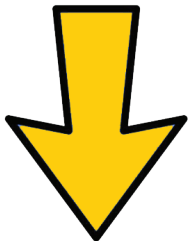
Abstracts must be submitted by email and received by Monday, June 1, 2015 at 5:00 pm. Acknowledgement that materials arrived on time will be sent via email.

#### Conference Registration

Individuals whose posters are selected must be in attendance at the time of presentation. Registration fees for the conference will be waived for individuals selected to present for the day of presentation only. Online registration information is available at <http://www.snowbirdcme.org>.

Presenters whose abstracts are accepted will be notified by July 1, 2015. Requirements for final preparation of the poster will be made available at that time as well as the specific date and times of presentation.

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### ABSTRACT PREPARATION

PLEASE NOTE: Only those submissions complying with the following will be reviewed. All completed applications received the stated deadline will be independently reviewed by the Program Committee and UNP volunteers.

The following content areas should be addressed: (a) purpose and/or objectives of the project, (b) description and results of the project, and (c) conclusions/implications for practice.

#### Required Format

- Abstracts will include a title page and the body of the abstract will be accepted in Word (.doc) or Rich Text Format (.rtf) file format and shall consist of 1) a title page and 2) abstract.
- Title page shall include the following information centered, single-spaced on one (1) 8 ½" X 11" page: 1) words Clinical Poster Abstract, 2) title of the abstract and 3) names of the presenter(s) with degrees and credentials and 4) contact information for primary author/presenter to include phone number and email address. (Mailing address may be included if desired).
- Abstract Body
  - o Format of Abstract: the length of the main abstract body shall not exceed 400 words (excluding the title and author information) and will appear single-sided on one (1) 8½" X 11" page.
  - o Margins: Use only the following margin: Top: 0.375"; Bottom: 0.5"; Left: 1.25", and Right: 1.25".
  - o Type Styles: Use letter quality, 12-point size type. The preferred type face is Times New Roman, but others will be accepted.
  - o Titles: Abstract titles should be centered and in upper case letters and may not exceed 100 characters
  - o Authors: Cite the author(s) name, degree(s) and credentials. ALL individuals involved in the study must be listed.
  - o Body of the abstract including the specific elements outlined in the selection criteria on page 2.
